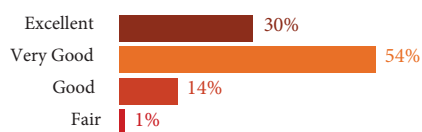
Key Statistics

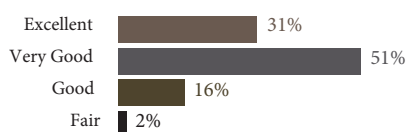
Event Rating

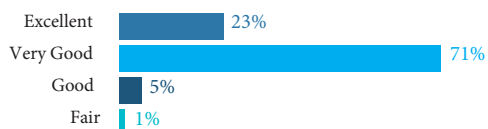
